

Cork (described in 1773 as 'a wild conceited extravagant foolish man'), on being raised to the peerage as Baron Muskerry, builds Upper Dromore House, Co. Cork, at an outlay of £33,000 and inhabits it for one night before 'directing that it be thrown down so that the value of the material might offset part of the building costs'. Muskerry will be Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Irish Freemasons, 1783-5. In 1788 he will request pensions 'as having no longer a fortune to support his rank'
